ABOUT THE CALIFORNIA PRIMARY:

The **Democratic Party**, **Libertarian Party**, and **American Independent Party** are allowing crossover voting at their primaries. This means that if you're a **No Party Preference voter** (unaffiliated), you can still participate in the primary, but you'll need to request a crossover ballot. You can do this online or at the polls.

To vote in the **Republican Party**, **Green Party**, or **Peace & Freedom Party** primaries you must be registered with that specific party. **Other party voters** or **No Party Preference voters** must re-register with one of these parties. You can re-register online at www.votolatino.org/register-to-vote.

OTHER INFO:

- Paper applications are available at most government buildings, such as libraries or DMV offices.
- You must re-register if you have changed your name, address, or political party preference.
